Dear Mr. Luer:

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) received a bid submitted by All American Asphalt (All American), on June 11, 2024, for the above Non-Federal-Aid contract to perform Slurry seal work. By this letter, Caltrans notifies All American that its bid is nonresponsive.

Caltrans refers All American to the 2023 Standard Specification Section 5-1.13, Subcontracting, which states in part:

"Except for a building construction non-federal-aid contract, perform work equaling at least 30 percent of the value of the original total bid with your employees and equipment you own or rent, with or without operator."

The above contract, while "non-federal-aid," is for highway construction, not building construction. Further, and as is reflected in the table below, Caltrans has determined that All American is not self-performing at least 30 percent of the "value of the original total bid."

As a result of All American not self-performing at least 30 percent of the value of its original total bid, All American's bid is nonresponsive.

Based on the above, Caltrans will proceed to award the contract to the lowest responsive bidder, provided that all requirements have been met.
