Gentlemen,

FBD Vanguard Construction, Inc. submitted our bid for the above referenced project through the Caltrans Electronic Bidding program. This letter is to notify the Department that after submittal, it was discovered that a clerical error had been made on the Subcontractor Listing form. The Subcontractor name listed on items 9 through 13 was incorrectly listed as Arctos Erosion Control, Inc. It should have been Wabo Landscape and Construction, Inc. This error was made by a simple "cut and paste" mistake when filling out the *Business Name* portion of the form. All the other information (*Location, Contractor License No., Public Works Contractor Registration No.*) is correctly aligned with Wabo Landscape & Construction, Inc.

We have attached the quotation sheet submitted to Vanguard by Wabo Landscape & Construction, Inc. to demonstrate the Bid Items that they priced by Wabo and used by Vanguard for this bid.

Pursuant to §4107 of the Public Contract Code, Vanguard is informing the Department of this error within 24 hours of the bid opening. Correction of this error is immaterial to Vanguard's bid and does not provide Vanguard with any advantage over any bidder. Please accept this letter as a correction to Vanguard's bid.





TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. CHANGES IN WORK: Should the owner, construction lender, or any public body or inspector direct any modification or addition to the work covered by this contract, the contract shall be adjusted accordingly. Modification or additions to the work shall be executed only when a Contract Change Order has been signed by both the Owner and Contractor. The change in the Contract Price caused by such Contract Change Order shall be as agreed in writing or if the parties are not in agreement as to the change in the Contract Price, then the Contractors actual cost for all labor, equipment, Sub-Contractors, and materials plus a Contractor's fee of 15% shall be the change in Contract Price.
- 2. FINANCING: If all or any of this agreement is to be financed through a financial institution, the Owner agrees to complete any such agreement on his own. Owner agrees to authorize lender to pay directly to Contractor the net proceeds of any such loan in payments as mutually agreed to between Owner and Contractor. Owner will make, execute and deliver all forms required by lender for such purposes.
- 3. PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS: If plans and/or separate specifications are prepared for this job they shall be attached to and become part of this agreement.
- 4. SUB CONTRACTS: The Contractor may subcontract portions of this work to properly licensed and qualified subcontractors.
- 5. ARBITRATION: Any controversy, claim or dispute arising out of or relating to this contract, the performance or the breach thereof, shall be settled by binding arbitration and judgment upon the award rendered by the Arbitrators may be entered in any court having jurisdiction thereof. Each party to this agreement shall select a neutral arbitrator. The arbitrators so selected shall in turn select a third neutral arbitrator who shall be the chairman of the Arbitration Hearing. If the two members are unable to agree on the appointment of a third member within thirty days, the third member shall be appointed by the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in the county which the work in question is located. If any party refuses or neglects to appoint his arbitrator or to participate in the arbitration within twenty (20) days after receiving notice thereof, the Arbitrator or Arbitrators are empowered to decide the controversy in accordance with whatever evidence is presented. The Arbitrators are authorized to award reasonable costs, expenses, and attorney's fees. Any decision of the Arbitration Board shall be binding by simple majority vote of the Arbitrators.
- 6. INCORPORATION: If this proposal is incorporated either by reference or physically into a Master Agreement, the terms, conditions, and exclusions are fully enforceable whether the agreement is signed or not.
- 7. TERMINATION: This agreement may be terminated for convenience by either party by giving two days written notice of termination to the other party, provided however; Client shall promptly pay to ARCTOS all amounts due. In addition client shall pay all extraordinary costs incurred by ARCTOS in fulfilling the termination for convenience of the contract. All costs and expenses so incurred shall be included in the full compensation due and owing Contractor under this agreement.
- 8. COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: In connection with the performance by Contractor of his duties pursuant to this Agreement, Contractor shall obtain and pay for all licenses required and comply with all federal, state, county and local laws, ordinances and regulations.
- WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION: Contractor shall carry Workmen's Compensation insurance on all his employees, and shall furnish Owner satisfactory evidence upon request.
- 10. ATTORNEY FEES: In the event it shall become necessary to bring suit in connection with any of the provisions of this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be paid such sum as the Court may adjudge as reasonable attorney fees.
- 11. INVESTIGATION: Contractor acknowledges that he has satisfied himself as to the nature of the work and the conditions prevailing where the work is to be performed. Contractor has satisfied himself particularly as to all federal, state, county and local laws ordinances and regulations bearing upon the performance of the Contractors duties, the character of labor, material and equipment needed to perform the work, and all other matters which can in any way affect the work or the cost thereof.
- 12. ASSIGNMENT: Contractor shall not assign his rights or duties under this Agreement without the written consent of the Owner.
- 13. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT: Time is the essence with respect to the completion of the work by Contractor. No modification or waiver of this Agreement shall be valid unless in writing and signed by the parties. Waiver of any breach of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or any other provisions of the agreement. This writing constitutes the entire agreement, and neither party is bound by any representation, warranty, promise, statement or information unless it is specifically set forth herein. Paragraph headings do not in any manner affect the scope of meaning of intent of its provisions. If a part of this agreement is held to be indefinite, uncertain, or enforceable, such determination shall not invalidate any other part of this agreement Subject to the provisions in Paragraph 12, above, this Agreement in all respects shall bind and inure to the benefits of their heirs, executers, administrators, successors, and assigns of the parties
- 14. TAXES AND ASSESMENTS: Taxes and assessments of all descriptions will be paid by Owner.
- 15. ALLOWANCES: If the correct price includes "allowances", and the cost of performing the work is covered by the allowance is either greater or less than the allowance then the contract price shall be increased or decreased accordingly. Unless otherwise requested by the owner in writing, the Contractor shall use his own judgment in accomplishing work covered by an allowance; the Contractor shall comply with the owner's request provided that the owner pays the additional cost.
- 16. INSURANCE AND DEPOSITS: Contractor shall carry workmen's compensation insurance for the protection of Contractor's employees during the progress of the work. Contractor will also carry General Liability Insurance of minimum \$2 Million. Owner shall obtain and pay for insurance against injury to his owner employees and persons under owner's direction and person on the job site at Owner's invitation.
- 17. FINES AND VIOLATIONS: Owner is responsible for the payment of fines/violations arising from non-compliance with environmental laws. If fines are the direct result of the activities of Contractor, Contractor may be liable for part of the damages. Owner not responding to recommendations by the Contractor does not constitute negligence on the part of the Contractor.
- 18. LIABILITY: The total liability of ARCTOS arising out of or related to this Agreement whether based on contract or tort, shall be limited to the compensation actually paid to ARCTOS for professional services. All claims by Client against ARCTOS shall be deemed waived unless written notice of the claim has been provided to ARCTOS within sixty (60) days after substantial completion off the Services performed under this Agreement. Client agrees that any claim or suit for damages made or filed against ARCTOS by Client will be made or filed solely against ARCTOS, a California corporation or its successors or assigns and that no shareholder or employee of ARCTOS shall be personally liable to Client for damages under any circumstances. This limitation of Liability applies to any and all claims, no matter how pleaded, including claims for errors and omissions, breach of contract, negligence, or breach of fiduciary duty and applies to all services performed under this Agreement. ARCTOS total liability to Client and anyone claiming by, through, or under Client for damages shall not exceed the percentage share that ARCTOS' negligence bears to the total negligence of all negligent entities and individuals.
- 19. RIGHT TO STOP WORK: Contractor shall have the right to stop work if any payment shall not be made timely to Contractor under this agreement; Contractor may keep the job idle until payments due are received. Furthermore, the Contractor may at his option terminate the contract and the owner shall be liable to the Contractor for breach of contract.
- 20. LIMITATIONS: No action of any character arising from or related to this contract or the performance thereof, shall be commenced be either party against the other more than 2 years after completion or cessation of work under this contract.
- 21. TERMS OF PAYMENT: All invoices are due within 30 days. Invoices not paid in 30 days will accrue finance charges of 1.5% per month.
