The Proposer agrees, if this Price Proposal is accepted, to enter into a Job Order Contract Master Agreement with the Department to perform the Work through Work Orders under the terms of the Job Order Contract Master Agreement. The Proposer bids for the Adjustment Factor to each of the bid items, unless noted otherwise. The sum of the Quantity Estimate in the Bid Item List multiplied by the Stipulated Unit Price is the total of the Price Proposal, which will be used to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. For bid items with pre-filled amounts in this Price Proposal, the Department pays the pre-filled bid item Adjustment Factor, Stipulated Unit Price and Item Total amounts.

Following execution of the JOC Master Agreement, Work Order will be created with selected Price Proposal items from its scope of work and corresponding quantities for those items in the Work Order. Work Order will be priced by the sum of the Work Order quantity multiplied by the Stipulated Unit Price. Proposer agrees to perform the work within the number of working days stated in the Work Order.

The Proposer agrees to enter its Adjustment Factor in Form B, manually calculate its Stipulated Unit Price and enter it in Form C using AASHTOWare Project Bids software and submit all relevant forms to Bidx.com, see JOC Electronic Bidding Guide for more details.

Proposer agrees:

1. If there is mathematical discrepancy in the Price Proposal between Adjustment Factor and Stipulated Unit Price, the bid may be found nonresponsive.
2. If the Adjustment Factor and Stipulated Unit Price are omitted, the bid may be found nonresponsive.
3. If the Adjustment Factor, Stipulated Unit Price and Item Total for the pre-filled bid items are modified, the bid may be found nonresponsive.
4. Entries are to be expressed in dollars and decimal fractions of a dollar. Symbols such as commas and dollar signs are ignored and have no significance

in establishing Stipulated Unit Price or Item Total.

5. Stipulated Unit Prices and Item Totals are interpreted by the number of digits and decimal placement. The Proposer shall round Stipulated Unit Price to the nearest hundredths decimal place.
